Job Title: PhD. Scholar (PS)

Type of Job: Research activities on millet/nutrition/integrated farming.

Role: Prepare policy documents relating to their reserch topics. Present a seminar in NCDS on millet/nutritional aspect of millet/ integrated farming every six months and prepare a working paper every year. Any other work assigned by the respective Project Coordinators.

Reporting to: Relevant Project Coordinators

Period of Contract: Contract will be for a period of One year or till the duration of the of the project which ever is earlier. There will be an evaluation at the end of six months or earlier. The duration of the fellowship may be extended beyond one year if the project continues and on satisfactory performance of the candidate as per evaluation by the Research Secretariat, Odisha Millet Mission/Integrated Farming, NCDS.

Location: The headquarters of the Scholars will be at NCDS. But the area of research of Millet Scholar must include at least one of the "Odisha Millets Mission" districts, but s/he may be asked to give feedback on other Millet Districts of Odisha as and when required. Similarly, the area of resech of Integrated farming Scholar must be Malkangiri District, but s/he may be asked to give feedback on other Districts of Odisha as and when required.

Languages: Excellent knowledge of written and spoken English is necessary. Working knowledge of local language is an advantage.

No of Posts: Two for Odisha Millets Mission and One for Integrated Farming. The number of schorships may increase, if budget permits.

Eligibility: Registered PhD. candidates in any university in Development Studies/Economics/Agricultural Economics/ Sociology/Anthropology or any other related subjects. The applicant should not be a recipient of any other fellowsip/scholarship.

Scholarship: The PS will get monthly scholarship and TA & DA as per organisation policy.
